Executive Summary:

The School District will continue upgrading computers as outlined in our district rotation schedule. 2017-2018 school year rotation will replace 150 teacher computers based on our 3-year rotation plan for the Middle School, Creekside Elementary, West Elementary, and Mountain View Elementary. Will purchase laptops for teachers rather than the typical desktop. Laptop cost will be more than a typical desktop. However, will give teachers the ability to take the laptop outside the classroom.

Upgrading three data servers as part of the 3-year rotation.

Purchasing 10 Smartboard projector upgrade kits to replace current older Smartboard projectors as they fail throughout the school year.

Will upgrade some wireless infrastructure to improve bandwidth and usability. This will allow us to test in smaller environment before upgrading the school district next year.

Yearly license fees for, SPAM filter, content filtering, backup software, Microsoft OS, Microsoft Office, Smart Notebook, radius server, wireless client, wireless controller care packs, and VMware licenses.
