STRATEGIC PLANNING PROCESS

The Spearfish Board of Education believes a formal strategic planning process is necessary to assure the effective and efficient operation of the school district. The board of education intends to ensure that the school district and its students will be better able to meet the demands of the future by instituting a comprehensive strategic planning process. A comprehensive planning process will also insure that scarce resources are utilized in the best ways possible to provide a quality educational program for all students.

The Spearfish School District will seek input for planning from all school district patrons and staff.

The Board will participate in the strategic planning process to the extent necessary to review progress on the implementation of priorities, initiatives, and long-range plans; to determine which goals have been achieved, whether any new efforts are needed and to review major issues that may affect the future.
