Agenda

2024-2025 1:1 Program

- Presented committee with HP x360 G10 demo which is an upgraded version of current HP x360 G6 laptop.
- Discussed options of iPads or Chromebooks for future purchases as moving towards more web-based programs and how that would look and affect 1:1 program for IT support, management, distribution, repairs, cost, software, Creekside 1:1, and in the classroom.
- Will continue to evaluate technology options that could benefit the 1:1 program.

Smartboards

- Epson currently discontinued ultra-throw projectors supporting 4:3 aspect ratio as focusing on just wide screen ratio.
- Contacted other projector vendors and also moving away from 4:3 ratio.
- Hypothesized on moving away from Smartboards to more cost-effective solutions such as Viewsonic interactive displays or ultra-short throw projectors.
- Reviewed options moving forward:
 - Replace current Smartboards with wide screen Smartboards to support a new projector.
 - Replace with interactive displays.
 - Move away from Smartboards/Interactive Displays and just use ultra-short throw projectors.
- Questions/Concerns
 - Cost? Viewsonic interactive display or ultra-short throw projectors cost much less than current Smartboards.
 - Do wider Smartboards fit current Smartboard installed classroom wall locations?
 - Mount locations for Interactive displays. Over current whiteboards?
 - Ultra-short throw projectors will need to project on classroom whiteboard.
 - Ability to move untethered with laptop and cast to projector more important consideration.
 - Are interactive boards still essential for learning.
 - Do we still use Smart Notebook software?
 - Planning on sending out a survey to Teachers to get more information on usage and need of Smartboards and Notebook software.

Computer Rotation

- 2024-20225 school year computer rotation schedule will include K-5 teacher laptops.
- Will purchase same laptop model as 6-12 1:1 program

Help Desk

- 200 Help Desk tickets have been submitted since beginning of school.
- At present, 30 HS/MS student laptops are out for repair at RTI covered by the laptop ADP insurance.
- Currently 1 open tickets in Incident IQ for IT Department.

Scale Server/Storage Upgrade

- Upgraded our district Scale server/storage hardware this summer which provided additional storage for a quota increase.
- Staff Network Drive (H) Quota increased to 15GB
- Staff GroupWise Quota increased to 3GB
- Student Network Drive (H) grades 6-12 increased to 1GB and K-5 increase to 500MB.

Incident IQ Events Calendar

- Added the Events Calendar module to Incident IQ to assist with scheduling events from outside entities and internal events.
- In process of training and implementation soon.
- This will provide better scheduling and coordination of events in the school district.

Elastic EDR (Endpoint Detection Response)

- EDR provides another layer of security that reads system logs and looks for anomalies that can detect network intrusions, ransomware attempts, and malware.
- Installed on staff computers for evaluation through March 2024.

Security Awareness

- Last phishing email sent out in September there were 27 failures.

eFax

- Transition from analog faxing to digital this summer has been a smooth transition using eFax.

District Tech Requests

- Request form will be available on November 20, 2023 through December 15, 2023.

Infinite Campus Update

- Aaron Norton discussed the new look of Campus with last update.
